

## Bowls for an artist and 3D paper sculptures

In this unit of work, the children will make a bowl using a mould and gummed paper.

They will collect visual notes using artists as inspiration for the design of their bowl. They will transfer designs onto their 3D artefact.

They will explore using paper forms to produce a 3D relief surface.



### **Key Concepts**

That brown gummed paper becomes sticky when wet and can be used to make a 3D structure.

That we can make 2D design that can be transferred onto a 3D surface.

That we can look at different artists work and make visual notes.

That paper can be used to make a 3D surface by curling, twisting and by quilling. Developing forming and sticking techniques.

Paper, brown gummed tape, pva glue, coloured papers
